What Are the Requirements to Acquire Philippine Dual ...

In the absence of Item 1 a: Acceptable Philippine Documents (The Philippine documents must show the same name, date of birth and Filipino as your nationality/citizenship) • Old Philippine Passport • Philippine Birth Certificate registered with the Local Civil Registrar of the place of birth

Dual Citizenship (RA 9225) - Philippine Consulate General ...

Submit the original and one duplicate copy of the following required documents to apply for reacquisition of Philippine citizenship: One (1) original and one (1) photocopy of the duly-accomplished Dual Citizenship application form, typed or printed legibly in black or blue ink

Dual Citizenship - The Official Website of the Philippine ...

If you were born in the Philippines, you need an original and 2 copies of your birth certificate issued by the Philippine Statistics Authority. If you are a married woman, you must also provide an original and 2 copies of your marriage certificate if you changed your surname after marriage.

Easy Ways to Apply for Dual Citizenship in the Philippines

Requirements for Travel Authority / Pass: Medical Certificate from DOH-accredited hospital or City or Municipal Health Office. Barangay Certification proving that the traveler has no COVID-19 symptoms for 14 days prior to travel date.

Citizenship Documents Dual Citizen - Submit a PSA Birth Certificate or Report of Birth and Original Identification Document issued by the Philippine Foreign Service Post (FSP) or the Bureau of Immigration (BI). In addition, bring also government-issued IDs either from Philippines or from second country of citizenship.

From May 15, 2019, the Consulate cannot authenticate the signatures on the following public documents: (1) notarized documents and (2) documents signed/issued/certified by a Federal, State, County, City, University or School Official. The change is due to the Philippines officially becoming a party to the Apostille Convention.

Arriving In The Philippines - Philippine Airlines

For dual recognition of a child (legitimate, illegitimate or adopted child who is under 18 years old) with foreign citizenship, acquisition of dual citizenship applies at the same time the mother or father reacquires Philippine citizenship. In this case, the petitioner must include the child as beneficiary in the dual-citizenship application.

In case of change of name, you must state the name appearing in your birth certificate or the old Philippine passport. 2. Original and two (2) photocopies of the following documents: Birth Certificate (if born in the Philippines) or Report of Birth (if born outside the Philippines) issued by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) on security ...

Dual Citizenship - The Official Website of the Philippine ...

In the absence of those two documents, a dual citizen traveling to the country may present the following documents in lieu of a Philippine passport: Original copy of Identification Certificate (IC); Original copy of the Order of Approval; and Original copy of the Oath of Allegiance.

Only Filipinos allowed entry to PH during pandemic ...

A valid Philippine passport; or A valid (one-way) Travel Document (issued in emergency cases only, i.e., lost PH passport) A former Filipino who reacquired or retained his/her Philippine citizenship via RA 9225, Citizenship Retention and Reacquisition Act of 2003 (as dual), is a FILIPINO.

All foreign passport holders not allowed to enter Philippines

U.S. citizens must have a visa to enter the Philippines for all travel purposes, including tourism. U.S. citizen residents of and visitors to the Philippines must contact the Philippine Bureau of Immigration (BI) for information on visa extensions. When traveling to the Philippines, it is extremely important to meet all the entry requirements established by the government. Citizens of many countries are not required to apply for a visa to travel to the Philippines. However, it is still necessary to have the following: Passport with a validity of six months beyond the expected stay

Philippines Visa Requirements and Travel Documents Required

Applicants who've availed of Dual Citizenship under RA 9225 Birth Certificate in Security Paper issued by the PSA or Certified True Copy of Birth Certificate issued by the LCR and duly authenticated by PSA. Transcribed Birth Certificate from the LCR is required when entries in PSA Birth Certificate are blurred or unreadable.
