Long term care facilities must develop and implement a baseline care plan for each resident within 48 hours of admission. The guidelines state the 48 hour baseline care plan must include "the instructions needed to provide effective and person-centered care of the resident that meet professional standards of quality care," including, but not limited to: initial goals based on admission orders, physician orders, dietary orders, therapy services, social services, and PASARR recommendation ...
