The original inhabitants of Andaman & Nicobar Islands were six aboriginal tribes, namely Andamanese, Jarawas, Onges, Sentinelese, Nicobarese and Shompens. The first four are from Negrito stock, confined to Andaman Islands. Nicobarese and Shompens trace their descent from Mongoloid ancestry, inhabiting southern group of Nicobar Islands.

Jarawas tribe live in South parts of Andaman and recognized as an Adivasi group. These Andamanese peoples are estimated at between 250–400 individuals in the Andaman Islands in India. Jarawas peoples have been interacted with modern world but still shunned by rest of the world.

5 Untouched and Uncontacted Tribes of Andaman Islands

The Andamanese peoples included the Great Andamanese and Jarawas of the Great Andaman archipelago, the Jangil of Rutland Island, the Onge of Little Andaman, and the Sentinelese of North Sentinel Island. At the end of the 18th century, when they first came into sustained contact with outsiders, an estimated 7,000 Andamanese remained.

Along with the Great Andamanese, the Jarawas, the Onge, the Shompen, and the Nicobarese, the Sentinelese are one of the six native and often reclusive peoples of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Unlike the others, the Sentinelese appear to have consistently refused any interaction with the outside world.
